


What am I?



I am a hawksbill sea turtle.

Hawksbill sea turtles are found throughout the tropical waters of the Atlantic, Pacific, and Indian Oceans. Hawksbill sea turtles can grow up to about 45 inches and about 150 pounds. Hawksbill sea turtles are often found near reefs and sponges which they love to feed on. They also like to eat mollusks, marine algae, crustaceans, sea urchins, fish, and jellyfish. Their hard shells protect them from sharks, crocodiles, octopuses, and humans. Hawksbill sea turtles are still very dangerous animals. People use their shells for many decorations.

A lot of different kinds of reef fish like to clean a green sea turtle's back! They can lay up to 100 to 200 eggs. They like to feed on sea grasses, algae, crabs, jellyfish, and sponges.





Green Sea Turtle Range





What am I?



I am a leatherback sea turtle.


A leatherback sea turtle is the largest sea turtle on earth. They can grow up to 7 feet and up to 2000 pounds! Leatherback sea turtles can be found throughout the world except Antarctica and the Arctic. Leatherback sea turtles can dive down for 4200 feet and can stay down for about 85 minutes. Leatherback sea turtles migrate the longest when it is time for breeding or egg laying. Some travel more than 3700 miles!

What is the smallest kind of sea turtles? What sea turtle's name is named of the olive color of its skin and shell?

What am I?



I am an olive ridley sea turtle.

The olive ridley sea turtle is the smallest turtle in the world. It can only reach up to 2 feet and can only weight up to 100 pounds. They are small but they migrate hundreds or thousands miles each year! They are one of the most endangered species of sea turtles. They nest between June to December. They usually feed on jellyfish, snails, crabs, and shrimp.
